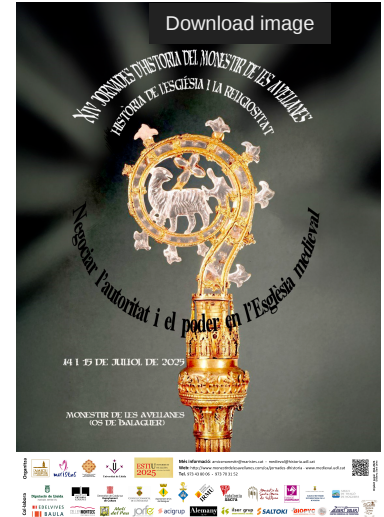
XIV Jornades d'Història de l'Església i la Religiositat
