

The aim of the Comtat d'Urgell Summer Courses is to combine scientific research and publication. The scientific meeting is offered to provide an annual halt after the intensity of the academic year, as a place to meet the leading specialists in research into the medieval period and to promote the exchange of ideas. At the same time, this contact with the leaders in research is combined with the interaction between divulgation and teaching, as should be in a summer course.
